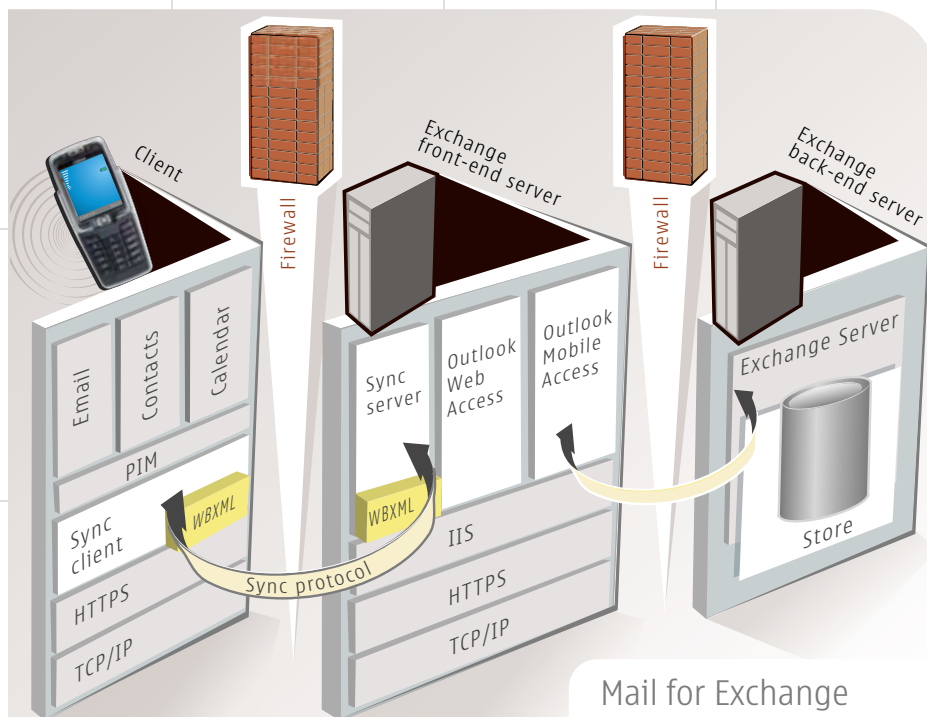
Mail for Exchange is the mobile email solution available for Nokia Eseries mobile devices. It utilizes Exchange ActiveSync, a protocol developed by Microsoft that enables wireless synchronization of email, calendar, and contact data between compatible Microsoft Exchange Server 2003 and mobile devices.

Using Microsoft Exchange Server 2003 SP2, the server uses Direct Push technology, which enables a seamless always-on email experience for Nokia Eseries devices. Using Nokia Eseries devices, this email experience is supported either over a mobile network or wireless LAN, depending on the specific device used.

To help ensure data security, Exchange ActiveSync uses an encrypted HTTPS connection that is established and maintained between the device and the server while information is being transferred.

Synchronization is much faster due to enhanced data compression, leading to a quicker experience when sending and receiving messages. The Exchange ActiveSync protocol also provides for control over mobile devices, including new abilities in the SP2 release to provision and enforce device security policies.

By collaborating with a number of service providers, Nokia has also maximized opportunities for companies without their own Microsoft Exchange Server to take advantage of Exchange ActiveSync with its broad range of functions to synchronize data with their Nokia Eseries devices.

Select Email and PIM Features

Always-on email:

- View inbox with an overview of email
- Create a new email
- Reply-to and Reply-to-All answering of email
- Forward incoming email
- Mark email as “read” or “unread”
- Delete email
- Add attachments to outgoing email
- Open or save received email attachments to the device for later viewing or editing*

Calendar synchronization:

- Synchronize calendar entries on the mobile device
- Choose from various calendar views (daily, weekly, monthly)

Contacts:

- Synchronize contact entries on the mobile device
- View, add, edit, and delete existing contact entries

* Viewing and/or editing file attachments is subject to the applications installed on the device in use

Select Administration Features

Preparation:

- Individual configuration of the device
- Device configuration for multiple users can be done using optional Intellisync Device Management from Nokia

Security:

- Support for SSL encryption

Microsoft Exchange Server 2003 SP2 supports the following additional security features:

- Contents are password locked
- Lock and Wipe functions:
 - An administrator can remotely lock and wipe a device they support if it is lost or stolen
 - Device is wiped if the password is entered incorrectly a predefined number of times

Synchronization:

- Manual, scheduled (or periodic), and always-on synchronization
- Manual and scheduled wireless synchronization of mobile devices is delivered using Microsoft Exchange Server 2003 SP1. In addition, always-on wireless synchronization is supported by Exchange Server 2003 SP2 Direct Push technology
- Synchronization according to individually configurable parameters
- Synchronization time filters

- The Symbian client can be used with the following Nokia Eseries devices: Nokia E50, Nokia E60, Nokia E61, Nokia E62, and Nokia E70
